To Comrade Maring.

Dear Comrade:

Received your telegram and regret that I have to leave Moscow before you come back to Russia. I wish you will go to China to help Quomintang in its propaganda work. After my arrival at Canton I will talk with Dr. Sun and we will invite you by telegram and I hope you will come to us as soon as possible.

I have tried to give you the travelling expenses for China before my leave, but because of shortage of funds here I can only let Comrade Chantaly to have about ~~four~~^{three} hundred **dollars** Mexican for his going-back journey. I will remit some money to you, or you borrow from Comrade Chantaly and I will give him back later.
